

## **First Interim Distribution Checks**

Over 5,000 claims have been filed against the Agape World bankruptcy estate and those claims are being reviewed and validated on an on-going basis.

To date, the Trustee has been able to validate over 800 claims. On December 10, 2009, in accordance with an Order of the United States Bankruptcy Court entered on December 1, 2009, the Trustee mailed First Interim Distribution checks to every investor with a validated claim.

### **IF YOU RECEIVED A CHECK:**

Your First Interim Distribution Check represents approximately .0078% of the amount of your filed claim.

The Trustee expects that, in the future, he will be able to make additional distributions as additional assets are liquidated and claims pursued. However, the timing and the amounts of the anticipated future distributions are not known at this time.

By depositing your First Interim Distribution check, you are not waiving your right to receive future monies.

### **IF YOU HAVE NOT RECEIVED A CHECK:**

As mentioned above, the process of reviewing and validating investor claims is ongoing.

As additional claims are resolved, the Trustee, with the Court's approval, will be making distributions to those investors who have not yet received checks.

Regardless of when you receive your First Interim Distribution check, every investor with a validated claim will be paid the same percentage of his/her claim.

If the Trustee requires additional information to validate your claim, we will contact you. In order to keep costs to a minimum and validate the filed claims as quickly as possible, please wait for us to contact you.

Please understand, the Trustee's professionals are reviewing and validating every claim filed to ensure that all monies recovered are distributed in accordance with the United States Bankruptcy Code. This is a time-consuming, but essential job function of the Trustee.

### **DID YOU FILE A CLAIM?**

In order to keep costs to a minimum and so that we may validate the remaining claims as quickly as possible, please review your own files before contacting the Trustee or his counsel to determine if you have filed your claim.

### **TAX REPORTING ISSUES:**

If you have questions regarding tax issues, you must speak with an accountant. The Trustee and his counsel are not qualified or authorized to advise you regarding tax issues.
